Wistron's statement regarding "Conflict Minerals"

Wistron adheres to the Code of Conduct of the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) and commits to conduct due diligence in accordance with the standards set out in the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for responsible supply chains of minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk areas (the "OECD Guidance").

- Wistron is responsible to ensure that suppliers conduct due diligence in accordance with the standards set out in the "OECD Guidance" for tin (Sn), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), gold (Au) and cobalt (Co) contained in suppliers' products to assure that suppliers' products do not directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups that are perpetrators of serious human rights abuse.
- Wistron commits to source only from 100% third-party audited smelters or refiners.
- Wistron guarantees that conflict-free minerals from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries are not banned.
- Wistron shall notify and ensure that suppliers comply with obligations and requirements of above declaration.
